



A 3x3 grid puzzle. The grid is divided into 9 squares. The numbers 1 through 6 are placed in the top-left, top-middle, top-right, middle-left, middle-middle, and middle-right squares. The number 3 is placed in the bottom-right square. The paths are as follows:

- Path 1:** Starts at the bottom-left square, moves up to the middle-left square, then right to the middle-middle square.
- Path 2:** Starts at the middle-left square, moves up to the top-left square, then right to the top-middle square.
- Path 3:** Starts at the middle-middle square, moves up to the top-middle square, then right to the top-right square.
- Path 4:** Starts at the middle-left square, moves down to the bottom-left square, then right to the bottom-middle square.
- Path 5:** Starts at the middle-middle square, moves down to the bottom-middle square, then right to the bottom-right square.
- Path 6:** Starts at the middle-right square, moves up to the top-right square, then left to the top-middle square.
