 - Row 6, Column 2: A triangle with an arrow pointing right.
 - Row 6, Column 3: A circle.
- Bottom-Right Quadrant (Rows 4-6, Columns 4-6):**
 - Row 4, Column 4: A circle.
 - Row 4, Column 5: A circle.
 - Row 4, Column 6: A circle.
 - Row 5, Column 4: A circle.
 - Row 5, Column 5: A circle.
 - Row 5, Column 6: A circle.
 - Row 6, Column 4: A circle.
 - Row 6, Column 5: A circle.
 - Row 6, Column 6: A circle.

The numbers are placed in the following cells:

- Row 4, Column 1: **3**
- Row 3, Column 5: **3**
- Row 5, Column 2: **5**
- Row 6, Column 4: **7**
- Row 6, Column 5: **6**
