Detailed description of the grid:
 - Row 1: Numbers 3, 2, (9), 8, (5).
 - Row 2: Circle at (1,1), number 4 at (1,2), number 6 at (4,2). A line connects (1,1) to (1,2).
 - Row 3: Circles at (2,1), (2,2), (2,3); number 3 at (3,3); number 4 at (5,3). Lines connect (2,1) to (2,2) and (2,2) to (2,3).
 - Row 4: Number 4 at (1,2), number 7 at (3,2).
 - Row 5: Number 2 at (1,1), circle at (1,2), number 3 at (3,3), number 9 at (4,3), number 6 at (5,3), number 5 at (6,3). Lines connect (1,1) to (1,2) and (1,2) to (2,2).
 - Row 6: Circle at (1,1), circle at (3,3), number 5 at (6,3). Lines connect (1,1) to (2,1) and (3,3) to (4,3).
 - Row 7: Number 7 at (1,1), number 2 at (3,1), number 3 at (4,1), number 8 at (5,1). Lines connect (1,1) to (2,1) and (3,1) to (4,1).
 - Row 8: Number 4 at (1,1), number 3 at (2,1), circle at (3,1), number 5 at (4,1). Lines connect (1,1) to (2,1) and (3,1) to (4,1).
 - Row 9: Circle at (4,1).
 - Row 10: Circle at (4,1), number 5 at (5,1). Lines connect (4,1) to (5,1).
