



The grid contains the following numbers and circles:

- Row 1:** (1,1)=1, (1,2)=2, (1,3)=6, (1,4)=5, (1,6)=7, (1,7)=8
- Row 2:** (2,1)=3, (2,2)=9, (2,3)=4, (2,5)=9, (2,7)=8
- Row 3:** (3,1)=2, (3,2)=9, (3,3)=8, (3,4)=3, (3,5)=6, (3,6)=1
- Row 4:** (4,2)=7, (4,3)=3, (4,4)=1
- Row 5:** (5,1)=3, (5,2)=6, (5,4)=2, (5,7)=4
- Row 6:** (6,2)=2, (6,3)=9, (6,5)=7

Circles are located at (1,3), (1,4), (2,1), (2,3), (2,4), (2,6), (3,1), (3,2), (3,5), (3,6), (4,1), (4,2), (4,3), (4,4), (4,5), (4,6), (5,1), (5,2), (5,3), (5,4), (5,5), (5,6), (5,7), (6,1), (6,2), (6,3), (6,4), (6,5), (6,6), (6,7).

Arrows indicate connections between numbers and circles. For example, an arrow points from 1 to the circle at (1,3), and another from 1 to the circle at (3,1). The grid is divided into four 3x3 quadrants by a central cross.
