- Row 5:
 - Column 1: 4 (arrow points up-right to column 2, row 4)
 - Column 2: 6 (arrow points up-right to column 3, row 4)
 - Column 3: 5 (arrow points up-right to column 4, row 4)
 - Column 4: 1 (arrow points up-right to column 5, row 4)
 - Column 5: 9 (arrow points up-right to column 6, row 4)
 - Column 6: 8 (circled, arrow points up-right to column 7, row 4)
- Row 6:
 - Column 1: 8 (circled, arrow points up-right to column 2, row 5)
 - Column 3: 2 (arrow points right to column 4, row 6)
 - Column 4: 5 (arrow points right to column 5, row 6)
 - Column 5: 1 (arrow points right to column 6, row 6)
