



PUZZLE MADNESS

Daily Tough Arrow Sudoku Puzzle for Monday 29th August 2022

A 9x9 grid for an Arrow Sudoku puzzle. The grid is divided into a 3x3 grid of 3x3 sub-grids. The puzzle is partially filled with numbers and arrows. The numbers are: 6 in row 1, column 2; 8 in row 1, column 4; 3 in row 2, column 3; 3 in row 3, column 4; 9 in row 5, column 3; 1 in row 7, column 1; 4 in row 7, column 2. Other arrows are placed in cells that are empty, indicating the direction and length of the numbers that should be placed there.
