- Bottom-left:** 2 (top-left), 1 (top-right), 2 (middle-left), 5 (middle-right), 7 (bottom-left), 6 (bottom-right), 9 (bottom-right).
- Bottom-middle:** 2 (top-left), 1 (top-right), 2 (middle-left), 5 (middle-right), 7 (bottom-left), 6 (bottom-right), 9 (bottom-right).
- Bottom-right:** 2 (top-left), 1 (top-right), 2 (middle-left), 5 (middle-right), 7 (bottom-left), 6 (bottom-right), 9 (bottom-right).
