- Board 7 (Bottom Left):** Numbers 3, 1, 9, 6, 7. Mines at (1,1), (1,2), (1,3), (2,1), (2,2), (2,3), (3,1), (3,2), (3,3), (4,1), (4,2), (4,3).
- Board 8 (Bottom Middle):** Numbers 1, 9, 8, 6. Mines at (1,1), (1,2), (1,3), (2,1), (2,2), (2,3), (3,1), (3,2), (3,3), (4,1), (4,2), (4,3).
- Board 9 (Bottom Right):** Numbers 7, 8, 5. Mines at (1,1), (1,2), (1,3), (2,1), (2,2), (2,3), (3,1), (3,2), (3,3), (4,1), (4,2), (4,3).
