- Path 1: 4 (row 2, col 1) → 9 (row 2, col 3) → 7 (row 1, col 3) → 4 (row 1, col 1) → 7 (row 4, col 1) → 1 (row 5, col 1) → 6 (row 6, col 1) → 5 (row 7, col 2) → 1 (row 8, col 2) → 3 (row 8, col 4) → 1 (row 8, col 3) → 9 (row 4, col 3) → 7 (row 4, col 1).
- Path 2: 6 (row 1, col 4) → 3 (row 1, col 5) → 2 (row 2, col 5) → 3 (row 2, col 6) → 7 (row 2, col 7) → 6 (row 2, col 8) → 2 (row 4, col 8) → 5 (row 5, col 8) → 4 (row 5, col 7) → 6 (row 5, col 6) → 1 (row 6, col 4) → 3 (row 8, col 4) → 1 (row 8, col 3) → 9 (row 4, col 3) → 7 (row 4, col 1).
- Path 3: 7 (row 1, col 2) → 9 (row 2, col 2) → 3 (row 2, col 3) → 2 (row 2, col 4) → 7 (row 4, col 4) → 5 (row 5, col 4) → 6 (row 5, col 5) → 4 (row 5, col 6) → 2 (row 7, col 6) → 1 (row 7, col 7) → 3 (row 8, col 7) → 1 (row 8, col 8) → 9 (row 4, col 8) → 7 (row 4, col 6) → 5 (row 5, col 6) → 6 (row 5, col 5) → 1 (row 6, col 4) → 3 (row 8, col 4) → 1 (row 8, col 3) → 9 (row 4, col 3) → 7 (row 4, col 1).
