A Factor Line Sudoku puzzle grid. The grid is 9x9. The numbers in the grid are: Row 1: 2, 6, 9, 1; Row 2: 1, 3, 5; Row 3: 9, 5; Row 4: 9, 4, 3, 7; Row 5: 7, 8, 9, 2; Row 6: 9, 4, 8; Row 7: 8, 9; Row 8: 4, 5, 6; Row 9: 9, 3. There are four empty cells marked with a circle (○) at (4,5), (5,3), (5,4), and (7,8). A factor line is drawn through the grid, starting at (4,5), going right to (4,6), down to (5,6), left to (5,5), down to (6,5), left to (6,4), down to (7,4), left to (7,3), down to (8,3), left to (8,2), down to (9,2), left to (9,1), up to (8,1), right to (8,2), up to (7,2), right to (7,3), up to (6,3), right to (6,4), up to (5,4), right to (5,5), up to (4,5).
