- Bottom-Right Quadrant:**
 - Row 1: 9 (circled, col 1)
 - Row 2: 9 (circled, col 1)
 - Row 3: 7 (col 1)
 - Row 4: 8 (col 1)
 - Row 5: 8 (col 1)

The paths are continuous lines connecting the circled numbers. The paths are as follows:

- Path 1:** Starts at (3,1) [6], goes down to (4,1) [8], then right to (4,2) [5], then right to (4,3) [9], then right to (4,4) [7], then right to (4,5) [8], then right to (4,6) [2].
- Path 2:** Starts at (2,1) [7], goes down to (3,1) [6], then down to (3,2) [3], then down to (3,3) [8], then down to (3,4) [5], then down to (3,5) [9], then down to (3,6) [7].
- Path 3:** Starts at (5,1) [8], goes down to (6,1) [6], then right to (6,2) [1], then right to (6,3) [5], then right to (6,4) [3].
- Path 4:** Starts at (1,1) [8], goes down to (2,1) [7], then down to (3,1) [6], then down to (3,2) [3], then down to (3,3) [8], then down to (3,4) [5], then down to (3,5) [9], then down to (3,6) [7].
