Detailed description of the grid content:

- Row 1:** Column 4 has number 3; Column 5 has number 9; Column 6 has number 6; Column 8 has number 2.
- Row 2:** Column 4 has number 7; Column 6 has number 5.
- Row 3:** Column 1 has number 5; Column 4 has a circled number 4; Column 8 has an empty circle.
- Row 4:** Column 1 has number 6; Column 2 has an empty circle; Column 3 has number 5; Column 6 has number 7; Column 9 has number 3.
- Row 5:** Column 2 has number 4; Column 4 has number 9; Column 5 has number 6.
- Row 6:** Column 2 has number 2; Column 9 has number 7.
- Row 7:** Column 1 has number 4; Column 8 has number 7; Column 9 has a circled number 6.
- Row 8:** Column 5 has number 5; Column 9 has number 8.
- Row 9:** Column 1 has number 9; Column 3 has number 1; Column 4 has an empty circle; Column 8 has number 3.

Gray lines connect the following pairs of empty circles:

- Row 3, Column 4 to Row 2, Column 5
- Row 3, Column 8 to Row 4, Column 7
- Row 4, Column 2 to Row 5, Column 2
- Row 4, Column 6 to Row 5, Column 5
- Row 5, Column 2 to Row 6, Column 3
- Row 5, Column 6 to Row 6, Column 7
- Row 6, Column 3 to Row 7, Column 4
- Row 6, Column 7 to Row 7, Column 8
- Row 7, Column 6 to Row 8, Column 7
- Row 7, Column 9 to Row 8, Column 8
- Row 8, Column 7 to Row 9, Column 6
- Row 8, Column 9 to Row 9, Column 8
- Row 9, Column 4 to Row 9, Column 3
