The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 1, 2, 4, 6 are placed in specific cells. The comparison symbols are as follows:
 Row 2: < between (2,1) and (2,2); < between (2,3) and (2,4); < between (2,4) and (2,5).
 Row 3: < between (3,2) and (3,3); > between (3,3) and (3,4).
 Row 4: > between (4,4) and (4,5).
 Row 5: < between (5,5) and (5,6).
 Row 6: > between (6,2) and (6,3); > between (6,4) and (6,5); < between (6,5) and (6,6).
 Additionally, there are four small 'v' symbols pointing down from the top row to the second row, and four small '^' symbols pointing up from the second row to the third row.
