The puzzle grid is a 5x5 square. The numbers and symbols are placed as follows:
 Row 1: Column 4 contains the number 4.
 Row 2: Column 2 contains the number 1.
 Row 3: Column 1 contains the number 1, Column 5 contains the number 2, and there is a less-than sign (<) between Column 3 and Column 4.
 Row 4: Column 2 contains the number 4, and there is a greater-than sign (>) between Column 2 and Column 3.
 Row 5: Column 5 contains the number 1, and there is a less-than sign (<) between Column 1 and Column 2.
 Between Row 1 and Row 2: A downward arrow (v) is below Column 5.
 Between Row 2 and Row 3: An upward arrow (^) is above Column 2, and a downward arrow (v) is below Column 4.
 Between Row 3 and Row 4: An upward arrow (^) is above Column 4, and a downward arrow (v) is below Column 3.
 Between Row 4 and Row 5: An upward arrow (^) is above Column 5, and a downward arrow (v) is below Column 1.
