The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 1, 3, 5, and 6 are placed in the following cells: (4,1), (4,7), (2,3), (2,4), (5,2), and (6,5). The comparison symbols are placed as follows:
 

- Row 1: Between (1,4) and (1,5) is '>'.
- Row 2: Between (2,2) and (2,3) is '^'.
- Row 3: Between (3,1) and (3,2) is '>', between (3,3) and (3,4) is '<', and between (3,6) and (3,7) is '^'.
- Row 4: Between (4,1) and (4,2) is '<', between (4,2) and (4,3) is '>', and between (4,6) and (4,7) is '^'.
- Row 5: Between (5,2) and (5,3) is '^', and between (5,5) and (5,6) is '^'.
- Row 6: Between (6,3) and (6,4) is '<', and between (6,5) and (6,6) is '^'.
