The puzzle grid is a 5x5 grid of squares. The numbers 4, 5, 1, 4, and 3 are placed in the second, third, fourth, and fifth columns of the first, third, fourth, and fifth rows, respectively. Comparison symbols are placed between adjacent squares: a greater-than sign (>) between the second and third squares of the second row; less-than (<) and greater-than (>) signs between the first and second, and second and third squares of the third row; greater-than (>) signs between the second and third, and third and fourth squares of the fourth row; and greater-than (>) signs between the first and second, and second and third squares of the fifth row. Additionally, there are caret (^) symbols above the second and third squares of the third row, and downward-pointing triangle (v) symbols below the fourth and fifth squares of the third row.
