The puzzle grid is an 8x8 square. The numbers 9, 2, 4, 4, 5, 4, 3, and 5 are placed in the first column, last column, and third column respectively. The comparison symbols are placed between the cells as follows:

- Row 1: > between (1,3) and (1,4); < between (1,5) and (1,6)
- Row 2: < between (2,3) and (2,4); > between (2,5) and (2,6)
- Row 3: < between (3,4) and (3,5); > between (3,7) and (3,8)
- Row 4: < between (4,7) and (4,8)
- Row 5: < between (5,3) and (5,4); > between (5,5) and (5,6)
- Row 6: > between (6,2) and (6,3); > between (6,4) and (6,5); < between (6,7) and (6,8)
- Row 7: > between (7,3) and (7,4); > between (7,5) and (7,6)
- Row 8: > between (8,1) and (8,2); > between (8,4) and (8,5)
