The puzzle grid is a 7x7 square. The numbers 2, 5, and 7 are placed in the following cells: (2,3), (3,6), and (5,5) respectively. The comparison symbols are placed as follows:

- Row 1: Between (1,1) and (1,2) is '>'.
- Row 2: Between (2,3) and (2,4) is '^', between (2,4) and (2,5) is '<', and between (2,6) and (2,7) is '^'.
- Row 3: Between (3,2) and (3,3) is '^', and between (3,5) and (3,6) is '^'.
- Row 4: Between (4,1) and (4,2) is '^', between (4,2) and (4,3) is '^', between (4,4) and (4,5) is '^', and between (4,6) and (4,7) is '^'.
- Row 5: Between (5,3) and (5,4) is '^', between (5,4) and (5,5) is '^', and between (5,6) and (5,7) is '^'.
- Row 6: Between (6,2) and (6,3) is '<', between (6,4) and (6,5) is '<', and between (6,6) and (6,7) is '^'.
- Row 7: Between (7,2) and (7,3) is '<', between (7,4) and (7,5) is '>', between (7,5) and (7,6) is '>', and between (7,6) and (7,7) is '>'.
