The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 1, 3, 4, 3, and 6 are placed in the following cells: (3,1), (2,3), (2,7), (5,7), and (6,4) respectively. The comparison symbols are placed as follows:

- Row 1: Between (1,5) and (1,6) is '>'.
- Row 2: Between (2,3) and (2,4) is '>'.
- Row 3: Between (3,1) and (3,2) is '>'.
- Row 4: Between (4,1) and (4,2) is '>', between (4,3) and (4,4) is '>', and between (4,5) and (4,6) is '>'.
- Row 5: Between (5,4) and (5,5) is '>', and between (5,6) and (5,7) is '>'.
- Row 6: Between (6,3) and (6,4) is '>'.

 Additionally, there are four small 'v' symbols pointing downwards from the top of the grid to the bottom of the grid, located at (2,3), (2,5), (3,2), and (5,7).
