The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 2, 1, 2, 6, 4 are placed in the first, third, fourth, fifth, and sixth rows respectively, in the second column. The number 6 is placed in the first row, sixth column. The number 1 is placed in the fourth row, second column. The number 2 is placed in the fifth row, third column. The number 6 is placed in the fifth row, fourth column. The number 4 is placed in the fifth row, fifth column. The comparison symbols are: Row 2, Column 4 to 5 is '<'; Row 4, Column 4 to 5 is '<'; Row 6, Column 2 to 3 is '>', Column 3 to 4 is '>', and Column 5 to 6 is '>'. There are also several empty cells with no symbols or numbers.
