The puzzle grid is a 7x7 square. The numbers and comparison symbols are placed as follows:
 Row 1: Cell 3 contains '4', Cell 4 contains '6'. Between Cell 4 and Cell 5 is a '>' symbol.
 Row 2: Cell 4 contains '5', Cell 5 contains '3', Cell 6 contains '2'.
 Row 3: Between Cell 2 and Cell 3 is a 'v' symbol (pointing down).
 Row 4: Between Cell 4 and Cell 5 is a 'v' symbol (pointing down).
 Row 5: Between Cell 1 and Cell 2 is a '<' symbol, between Cell 2 and Cell 3 is a '>' symbol, between Cell 5 and Cell 6 is a '<' symbol.
 Row 6: Between Cell 1 and Cell 2 is a 'v' symbol (pointing down), between Cell 2 and Cell 3 is a '^' symbol (pointing up), between Cell 5 and Cell 6 is a '<' symbol.
 Row 7: Between Cell 1 and Cell 2 is a '^' symbol (pointing up), between Cell 2 and Cell 3 is a '>' symbol, Cell 3 contains '4', Cell 4 contains '3'.
 Row 8: Between Cell 4 and Cell 5 is a '^' symbol (pointing up), between Cell 5 and Cell 6 is a '>' symbol, between Cell 6 and Cell 7 is a '^' symbol (pointing up).
