Detailed description of the Futoshiki puzzle grid: The grid is 7 columns wide and 9 rows high. Row 1: Column 5 contains '4', followed by a right-pointing arrow (>) and two empty cells. Row 2: Column 3 contains '7'. Row 3: Column 4 contains '2', followed by an empty cell, a left-pointing arrow (<), and an empty cell. Row 4: Column 1 has an upward arrow (^) below it; Column 2 has an upward arrow (^) above it; Column 6 has a downward arrow (v) below it; Column 7 has an upward arrow (^) above it. Row 5: Column 1 has a right-pointing arrow (>) to its right; Column 3 has a right-pointing arrow (>) to its right; Column 4 has a downward arrow (v) below it; Column 5 has an upward arrow (^) above it and contains '3'; Column 6 has a downward arrow (v) below it; Column 7 has a downward arrow (v) below it. Row 6: Column 4 has an upward arrow (^) above it; Column 5 has a left-pointing arrow (<) to its left. Row 7: Column 3 has a downward arrow (v) below it. Row 8: Column 2 contains '4'; Column 3 has a downward arrow (v) below it; Column 4 contains '7'; Column 6 contains '2'.
