The puzzle grid is a 5x5 square. The numbers 3, 4, 1, and 5 are placed in the first column of rows 2, 3, 4, and 5 respectively. The comparison symbols are as follows:  
 - Row 2: A downward arrow (v) is below the first cell. Greater-than symbols (>) are between the first and second cells, and between the third and fourth cells.  
 - Row 3: An upward arrow (^) is above the second cell. A greater-than symbol (>) is between the fourth and fifth cells.  
 - Row 4: A downward arrow (v) is below the third cell.  
 - Row 5: An upward arrow (^) is above the second cell. A downward arrow (v) is below the fifth cell.
