The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 3, 5, and 6 are placed in the second, third, and fourth rows respectively. The comparison symbols are placed between the cells as follows:

- Row 2: Between column 4 and 5, a less-than sign (<).
- Row 3: Between column 5 and 6, a greater-than sign (>).
- Row 4: Between column 5 and 6, a greater-than sign (>).
- Row 5: Between column 1 and 2, a greater-than sign (>); between column 3 and 4, a less-than sign (<); between column 4 and 5, a less-than sign (<).
- Row 6: Between column 1 and 2, a less-than sign (<); between column 4 and 5, a greater-than sign (>).

Additionally, there are small arrows indicating row and column constraints:

- Between row 2 and 3, column 5: a downward arrow (v).
- Between row 3 and 4, column 6: a downward arrow (v).
- Between row 4 and 5, column 2: an upward arrow (^).
- Between row 4 and 5, column 5: an upward arrow (^).
- Between row 5 and 6, column 4: a downward arrow (v).
- Between row 5 and 6, column 6: an upward arrow (^).
