The puzzle grid is a 7x7 square. The numbers 4, 3, 2, 5, 2, 7 are placed in the following cells: (4,3), (4,4), (4,9), (5,1), (6,1), (7,3).
 The comparison symbols are placed as follows:
 Row 1: Between (1,5) and (1,6) is '>', between (1,6) and (1,7) is '>'.
 Row 2: Between (2,2) and (2,3) is '<', between (2,4) and (2,5) is '<'.
 Row 3: Between (3,3) and (3,4) is '<'.
 Row 4: Between (4,3) and (4,4) is '>', between (4,5) and (4,6) is '<'.
 Row 5: Between (5,1) and (5,2) is '>', between (5,2) and (5,3) is '<', between (5,4) and (5,5) is '>'.
 Row 6: Between (6,3) and (6,4) is '<', between (6,5) and (6,6) is '>'.
 Row 7: Between (7,1) and (7,2) is '>', between (7,4) and (7,5) is '>'.
 Additionally, there are four comparison symbols pointing to specific cells:
 - A downward arrow (v) points to cell (2,2).
 - An upward arrow (^) points to cell (1,6).
 - An upward arrow (^) points to cell (4,4).
 - A downward arrow (v) points to cell (4,6).
