The puzzle grid is a 5x5 grid of squares. The numbers 1, 2, and 3 are placed in the first, fourth, and fifth rows, respectively, in the first column. Comparison symbols are placed between certain squares: a greater-than sign (>) between the second and third squares of the second row; a less-than sign (<) between the second and third squares of the fourth row; a less-than sign (<) between the second and third squares of the fifth row; a less-than sign (<) between the third and fourth squares of the second row; a less-than sign (<) between the third and fourth squares of the third row; a less-than sign (<) between the fourth and fifth squares of the second row; a less-than sign (<) between the fourth and fifth squares of the third row; a less-than sign (<) between the fourth and fifth squares of the fourth row; a less-than sign (<) between the fourth and fifth squares of the fifth row; and a greater-than sign (>) between the fourth and fifth squares of the fourth row.
