The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers and comparison symbols are placed as follows:
 Row 1: All cells are empty.
 Row 2: Cell (2,1) contains '2', (2,2) contains '4', (2,3) is empty, (2,4) contains '6', (2,5) contains '>', (2,6) contains '1'.
 Row 3: Cell (3,1) is empty, (3,2) is empty, (3,3) is empty, (3,4) is empty, (3,5) contains '<', (3,6) is empty.
 Row 4: Cell (4,1) contains '4', (4,2) is empty, (4,3) is empty, (4,4) is empty, (4,5) is empty, (4,6) contains '<'.
 Row 5: Cell (5,1) is empty, (5,2) is empty, (5,3) is empty, (5,4) contains '5', (5,5) is empty, (5,6) is empty.
 Row 6: Cell (6,1) contains '6', (6,2) is empty, (6,3) is empty, (6,4) is empty, (6,5) contains '<', (6,6) contains '<'.
 Comparison symbols are also placed between rows:
 Between Row 1 and 2: A downward arrow (v) below cell (1,1).
 Between Row 2 and 3: An upward arrow (^) above cell (3,1) and an upward arrow (^) above cell (3,6).
 Between Row 3 and 4: A downward arrow (v) below cell (3,4).
 Between Row 4 and 5: A downward arrow (v) below cell (4,1), a downward arrow (v) below cell (4,2), an upward arrow (^) above cell (5,4), and a downward arrow (v) below cell (5,6).
 Between Row 5 and 6: A downward arrow (v) below cell (5,4).
