The puzzle grid is a 6x6 square. The numbers 3, 5, 6, and 3 are placed in the top-right, second row third column, bottom row third column, and bottom row fourth column respectively. The comparison symbols are placed between the cells as follows:
 Row 1: Between column 3 and 4 (down arrow), between column 4 and 5 (right arrow).
 Row 2: Between column 1 and 2 (down arrow), between column 3 and 4 (right arrow).
 Row 3: Between column 1 and 2 (left arrow), between column 2 and 3 (right arrow), between column 5 and 6 (left arrow).
 Row 4: Between column 1 and 2 (right arrow), between column 2 and 3 (up arrow), between column 3 and 4 (down arrow), between column 4 and 5 (down arrow), between column 5 and 6 (down arrow).
 Row 5: Between column 2 and 3 (right arrow), between column 4 and 5 (down arrow), between column 5 and 6 (down arrow).
 Row 6: Between column 5 and 6 (up arrow).
