The grey lines are as follows:

- Row 1: A diagonal line from (1,2) to (1,5).
- Row 2: A horizontal line from (2,2) to (2,3), a diagonal line from (2,3) to (2,4), a horizontal line from (2,4) to (2,5), and a diagonal line from (2,5) to (2,6).
- Row 3: A horizontal line from (3,2) to (3,3), a diagonal line from (3,3) to (3,4), a horizontal line from (3,4) to (3,5), and a diagonal line from (3,5) to (3,6).
- Row 4: A horizontal line from (4,2) to (4,3), a diagonal line from (4,3) to (4,4), a horizontal line from (4,4) to (4,5), and a diagonal line from (4,5) to (4,6).
- Row 5: A horizontal line from (5,2) to (5,3), a diagonal line from (5,3) to (5,4), a horizontal line from (5,4) to (5,5), and a diagonal line from (5,5) to (5,6).
- Row 6: A horizontal line from (6,2) to (6,3), a diagonal line from (6,3) to (6,4), a horizontal line from (6,4) to (6,5), and a diagonal line from (6,5) to (6,6).
