



PUZZLE MADNESS

Daily Hard Greater Than Sudoku Puzzle for Tuesday 12th June 2012

A 9x9 grid intended for a Greater Than Sudoku puzzle. The grid is divided into a 3x3 grid of 3x3 subgrids by thicker black lines. Various comparison symbols (> or <) are placed along the boundaries between cells, indicating the relative values of the digits in adjacent cells. For example, a '>' symbol means the digit in the cell on the left is greater than the digit in the cell on the right.
