



PUZZLE MADNESS

Daily Hard Greater Than Sudoku Puzzle for Tuesday 15th March 2016

A 9x9 grid for a Greater Than Sudoku puzzle. The grid is divided into three 3x3 boxes by thick black lines. Numerical values are placed in some cells, and comparison operators (> or <) are placed in other cells to indicate the relative values of adjacent cells.

- Row 1: Cells (1,1), (1,2), (1,3), (1,4), (1,5), (1,6), (1,7), (1,8), (1,9) are empty.
- Row 2: Cells (2,1), (2,2), (2,3), (2,4), (2,5), (2,6), (2,7), (2,8), (2,9) are empty.
- Row 3: Cells (3,1), (3,2), (3,3), (3,4), (3,5), (3,6), (3,7), (3,8), (3,9) are empty.
- Row 4: Cells (4,1), (4,2), (4,3), (4,4), (4,5), (4,6), (4,7), (4,8), (4,9) are empty.
- Row 5: Cells (5,1), (5,2), (5,3), (5,4), (5,5), (5,6), (5,7), (5,8), (5,9) are empty.
- Row 6: Cells (6,1), (6,2), (6,3), (6,4), (6,5), (6,6), (6,7), (6,8), (6,9) are empty.
- Row 7: Cells (7,1), (7,2), (7,3), (7,4), (7,5), (7,6), (7,7), (7,8), (7,9) are empty.
- Row 8: Cells (8,1), (8,2), (8,3), (8,4), (8,5), (8,6), (8,7), (8,8), (8,9) are empty.
- Row 9: Cells (9,1), (9,2), (9,3), (9,4), (9,5), (9,6), (9,7), (9,8), (9,9) are empty.

Comparison operators present in the grid:

- Row 1: (1,4)<, (1,7)>, (1,8)<
- Row 2: (2,1)>, (2,2)>, (2,3)<, (2,4)<, (2,7)>, (2,8)<, (2,9)>
- Row 3: (3,1)>, (3,2)<, (3,4)<, (3,7)>, (3,8)<, (3,9)<, (3,9)>
- Row 4: (4,1)>, (4,2)<, (4,3)<, (4,4)>, (4,5)<, (4,6)<, (4,7)>, (4,8)<, (4,9)>
- Row 5: (5,1)>, (5,2)<, (5,3)<, (5,4)>, (5,5)<, (5,6)<, (5,7)>, (5,8)<, (5,9)<, (5,9)>
- Row 6: (6,1)>, (6,2)<, (6,3)<, (6,4)>, (6,5)<, (6,6)<, (6,7)>, (6,8)<, (6,9)<, (6,9)>
- Row 7: (7,1)>, (7,2)<, (7,3)<, (7,4)>, (7,5)<, (7,6)<, (7,7)>, (7,8)<, (7,9)<, (7,9)>
- Row 8: (8,1)>, (8,2)<, (8,3)<, (8,4)>, (8,5)<, (8,6)<, (8,7)>, (8,8)<, (8,9)<, (8,9)>
- Row 9: (9,1)>, (9,2)<, (9,3)<, (9,4)>, (9,5)<, (9,6)<, (9,7)>, (9,8)<, (9,9)<, (9,9)>
