



# PUZZLE MADNESS

Daily Hard Greater Than Sudoku Puzzle for Saturday 4th February 2023

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This is a 9x9 grid for a Greater Than Sudoku puzzle. The grid is divided into three 3x3 boxes by thick black lines. Numerical values are not provided; instead, comparison operators (<, >, ^, v) are placed in some cells to indicate the relative values of the numbers in adjacent cells. The operators are as follows:

- <: The number in the cell is less than the number in the adjacent cell.
- >: The number in the cell is greater than the number in the adjacent cell.
- ^: The number in the cell is greater than or equal to the number in the adjacent cell.
- v: The number in the cell is less than or equal to the number in the adjacent cell.

The puzzle requires solving for a unique 9x9 grid of digits (1-9) where each digit appears exactly once in every row, column, and 3x3 box, and it must also satisfy the given comparison constraints.
