The paths are represented by thick grey lines connecting diamond-shaped nodes. The paths are:

- Path 1: (1,1) → (1,3) → (2,3) → (2,4) → (3,4) → (3,5) → (4,5) → (4,6) → (5,6) → (5,7) → (6,7) → (6,8)
- Path 2: (1,2) → (2,2) → (2,3) → (3,3) → (3,4) → (3,5) → (4,5) → (4,6) → (5,6) → (5,7) → (6,7) → (6,8)
- Path 3: (1,4) → (1,5) → (2,5) → (2,6) → (3,6) → (3,7) → (4,7) → (4,8) → (5,8) → (5,9) → (6,9) → (6,10)
- Path 4: (1,6) → (1,7) → (2,7) → (2,8) → (3,8) → (3,9) → (4,9) → (4,10) → (5,10) → (5,11) → (6,11) → (6,12)
