- Path 2: (1,4) to (1,5) to (2,5) to (2,6) to (3,6) to (3,7) to (4,7) to (4,8) to (5,8) to (5,9) to (6,9).
- Path 3: (1,6) to (1,7) to (2,7) to (2,8) to (3,8) to (3,9) to (4,9) to (4,10) to (5,10) to (5,11) to (6,11).
- Path 4: (1,8) to (1,9) to (2,9) to (2,10) to (3,10) to (3,11) to (4,11) to (4,12) to (5,12) to (5,13) to (6,13).
