- Path 1: (1,1) → (1,2) → (2,2) → (2,3) → (3,3) → (3,4) → (4,4) → (4,5) → (5,5) → (5,6) → (6,6)
- Path 2: (1,3) → (1,4) → (2,4) → (2,5) → (3,5) → (3,6) → (4,6) → (4,7) → (5,7) → (6,7)
- Path 3: (1,5) → (1,6) → (2,6) → (2,7) → (3,7) → (3,8) → (4,8) → (4,9) → (5,9) → (6,9)
- Path 4: (1,7) → (1,8) → (2,8) → (2,9) → (3,9) → (3,10) → (4,10) → (4,11) → (5,11) → (6,11)
