The paths are as follows:

- Middle-left quadrant: A path from (3,2) to (4,2) to (4,1) to (5,1) to (5,2) to (6,2).
- Middle-right quadrant: A path from (3,6) to (4,6) to (4,5) to (5,5) to (6,5).
- Bottom-left quadrant: A path from (6,3) to (6,4) to (6,5) to (6,6) to (5,6) to (5,5) to (4,5) to (4,4) to (4,3) to (3,3) to (3,2) to (3,1) to (2,1) to (2,2) to (2,3) to (2,4) to (2,5) to (2,6) to (1,6) to (1,5) to (1,4) to (1,3) to (1,2) to (1,1) to (2,1).
- Bottom-right quadrant: A path from (6,8) to (6,9) to (5,9) to (5,8) to (4,8) to (4,7) to (4,6) to (4,5) to (4,4) to (4,3) to (4,2) to (4,1) to (3,1) to (3,2) to (3,3) to (3,4) to (3,5) to (3,6) to (2,6) to (2,5) to (2,4) to (2,3) to (2,2) to (2,1) to (1,1) to (1,2) to (1,3) to (1,4) to (1,5) to (1,6) to (2,6).
