The paths are represented by thick grey lines connecting the numbers. The paths are:

- Path 1: 5 (row 1, col 1) → 4 (row 2, col 2) → 2 (row 2, col 3) → 5 (row 4, col 3) → 2 (row 4, col 4) → 1 (row 4, col 5) → 9 (row 5, col 5) → 7 (row 5, col 6) → 4 (row 6, col 6).
- Path 2: 2 (row 2, col 3) → 5 (row 4, col 3) → 4 (row 5, col 4) → 3 (row 5, col 5) → 8 (row 6, col 5) → 4 (row 6, col 6).
- Path 3: 1 (row 3, col 1) → 2 (row 5, col 1) → 9 (row 5, col 2) → 7 (row 5, col 3) → 4 (row 6, col 3) → 6 (row 6, col 4).
- Path 4: 6 (row 6, col 1) → 1 (row 5, col 1) → 2 (row 5, col 2) → 7 (row 5, col 3) → 4 (row 6, col 3) → 6 (row 6, col 4).
