 - Row 6: Number 5 at (6,1), circle at (6,2), circle at (6,3).
- Bottom-Right Quadrant (Rows 4-6, Columns 4-6):**
 - Row 4: Circle at (4,4), number 6 at (4,4), number 4 at (4,5), circle at (4,6).
 - Row 5: Number 8 at (5,4), number 9 at (5,5), circle at (5,5), circle at (5,6).
 - Row 6: Number 3 at (6,4), number 9 at (6,6).

The lines connect the circles and numbers as follows:

- Circle at (1,1) connects to number 8 at (2,1) and number 6 at (2,2).
- Circle at (2,1) connects to number 2 at (3,1) and number 1 at (3,2).
- Circle at (1,5) connects to number 5 at (1,6) and number 4 at (2,6).
- Circle at (3,5) connects to number 7 at (3,4) and number 9 at (3,5).
- Circle at (4,4) connects to number 6 at (4,4) and number 4 at (4,5).
- Circle at (5,5) connects to number 8 at (5,4) and number 9 at (5,5).
- Circle at (6,2) connects to number 5 at (6,1) and number 3 at (6,3).
- Circle at (6,3) connects to number 3 at (6,4) and number 9 at (6,6).
