 - Row 4: 7 at (4,4), 9 at (4,5), 6 at (4,6).
 - Row 5: 6 at (5,4), 1 at (5,5), 1 at (5,6).
 - Row 6: 1 at (6,4), 1 at (6,5), 1 at (6,6).

Grey lines connect the following pairs of cells:

- (1,3) to (1,4)
- (1,4) to (1,5)
- (2,4) to (2,5)
- (2,5) to (2,6)
- (3,1) to (3,2)
- (3,2) to (3,3)
- (3,3) to (3,4)
- (4,1) to (4,2)
- (4,2) to (4,3)
- (4,3) to (4,4)
- (5,1) to (5,2)
- (5,2) to (5,3)
- (5,3) to (5,4)
- (6,1) to (6,2)
- (6,2) to (6,3)
- (6,3) to (6,4)
